1. Academic Processes:

- a. **Allotment of Subjects:** The Head of the Department in consultation with all faculty will allot subjects for the faculty. For this, first a wish list from the faculty in priority order will be obtained. All efforts will be made to allot at least one subject from the wish list.
- b. **Lesson Plan:** Each teacher upon allotment of a theory subject will prepare a lesson plan indicating number of hours needed and on each hour what topic would be covered. This will be scrutinized and approved by Head of the Department and Principal.
- c. **Progress Monitoring:** The teacher while actually delivering the course would make entries in his / her “record of class work” and put up this for HOD’s inspection every week. Any deviation from approved lesson plan has to be ratified by HOD. Once in two weeks this is scrutinized by the Principal. This will help in monitoring of the progress in lesson delivering and coverage of syllabus.

- d. **Class Tests / Monthly Tests:** The conduct of tests marks submission is centralized and report cards will be sent to parents within 15 days from the last test.
- e. **Attendance monitoring:** Daily absentee's statement will be collected by class advisor and information to parent will be sent. Administrative Officer monitors and informs the Principal about any lapse on Advisor side.

2. Non Academic:

The Head of the Department in consultation with class advisor will plan non academic activity, like Clubs / Association / Industrial visit / Cultural / Paper presentation etc. Principal gives the final consent.

3. Purchase:

The lab in charge has to put up the requirements to Head of the Department who in turn approaches the Principal. The competitive quotations are received by the lab in charge and HOD calls for negotiation and the price is fixed. The Principal does a final price negotiation and puts up to Management for approval.

4. Maintenance:

Building and other physical maintenance will be looked after by Estate Officer with the consent of the Principal and Management. Equipment maintenance is initiated by the Lab in charge. Quotations have to be obtained with Principal's approval and the maintenance is carried out.

5. Administrative:

There are well defined processes for various section of the administration. The sections are: Student Affairs, Examination, Establishment, Accounts and Cash & External agencies.

Nature and extent of involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs / improvements:

The faculty will have direct access to Principal to discuss individual suggestion. The department meeting, HOD committee meeting, staff meeting are other forums for faculty to express their opinion / suggestion.

Students through class committee may inform their opinion on academic affairs / improvement. The class committee will meet at least 4 times in a semester.

Mechanism / Norms and Procedure for democratic / good governance:

All major policy matters will be discussed in the weekly meeting of Head of Department committee and a frank, open discussion is done. Decision is taken collectively. In department, similarly at the faculty meeting, all issues are discussed thoroughly and decisions will be taken. Any suggestion from any stake holder will be personally looked into by the Principal.

Student feedback on Institutional Governance / faculty performance:

1. It is proposed to form a Class committee consisting of various sections of students which will meet at least 4 times under a Chairman to get the feedback.
2. There will be an in camera meeting of class committee with Principal once in a semester where students can tell their grievances if any, suggest ways for improvement.

Grievances redressal mechanism for faculty, staff and students:

Any faculty / Staff and student can write to the Principal through Head of the Department about their grievance and Principal looking into the merit of the case may inform individual or through Head of Department. There is a Grievance redressal committee which also helps.

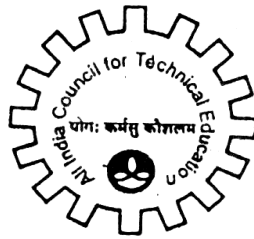
